

Lab Activities (Biology)











The students prepared slides from onion root tips and observed the stages of mitosis in dividing cells under a microscope. They learned about the importance of mitosis for cell growth, repair and reproduction. They enjoyed seeing the chromosomes and their structures.

Class: 10-A: Human Circulatory System and Double Circulation:

The students presented the topics of human circulatory system and double circulation using charts and models. They illustrated the main components and functions of the circulatory system, such as the heart, blood vessels and blood cells. They explained how double circulation ensures efficien oxygen delivery and carbon dioxide removal in mammals.

The students studied the human respiratory system and heart in the laboratory. They observed preserved specimens of human lungs, trachea and heart. They identified the main parts and learned about the process of breathing, gas exchange and blood pumping. They measured their own was rate and blood pressure.



Seminar on "Study Abroad"

A seminar on 'Study in Abroad' was conducted in S. D. Jain Modern School on 24 July, 2023 for the students of Std XII. The lead Speaker Mr. Vikas Gupta from Education Cube, discussed about the test Preparations required to study abroad, such as PTE, GMAT, TOEFL and IELTS. He briefly discussed the scores required, score distribution. He stated 40+ under graduation and 50+ post-graduation courses with Open work permit duration.

The speaker gave a step by step guide to choose an apt university one wants to study in. He said "Choosing the right university includes a lot of steps, one of which is finding the right program itself". He gave a lot of guidance with regards to availability of a program, tuition fee, scholarships, acceptance rate and rankings.
