



Apples are delicious, versatile, and one of the most consumed fruits in the world. Produced by an apple tree (*Malusdomestica*), they originate from Central Asia.


Here are some interesting facts about apples and apple trees:

A teacher's love for his/her student is endless just like a mother's concern or a father's care.




