Competing against top young talents from across the globe, Pragnika delivered a flawless performance, securing a perfect 9/9 score. Notably, she was the only Indian player across all age categories to win a gold medal.

She has demonstrated outstanding skills, concentration and sportsmanship by winning several prestigious chess tournaments at the State, National and Open/FIDE levels. Her journey from learning chess to dominating an international arena in just over a year is a testament to her dedication, skill and fearless approach. Her rigorous practice, strategic mindset, and unwavering focus helped her outshine formidable opponents, including the U-7 national champion.

Skill-Based Events






The events reflected the belief that "Creative minds inspire others" and "Creativity is a natural extension of our enthusiasm."


Experiential Learning through Activities and Subject Integration

Project CACA – Mental Health Workshop at S.D. Jain Modern School



On Saturday, 7 June 2025 (9:30 AM–2:00 PM), S.D. Jain Modern School conducted a powerful Project CACA workshop on Parenting Skills, Mental Health and Wellness, featuring eminent psychologist Ms. Sakshi Mishra as the resource person.

CACA ("Children Against Child Abuse") is a holistic safety initiative—initiated in 2015, rooted in WHO life skills and moral education, and supported by workbooks, teacher-parent guides, and legal awareness programmes—aimed at child protection and well-being. During the session, Ms. Sakshi Mishra led engaging activities prompting teachers to reflect: "My parenting beliefs when I grew up" versus "What I now believe and want to practice as a parent". Through these exercises, educators explored eight dimensions of well-being: environmental, intellectual, physical, emotional, social, financial, spiritual, and psychological/occupational.

Ms. Sakshi Mishra emphasized the vital role teachers and parents play in recognizing emotional distress—like anxiety, peer pressure, and academic strain—and responded by encouraging empathy, active listening, and open communication between home and school.
