Navratri Spirit in Action : A Glimpse into Std I – IV Assemblies



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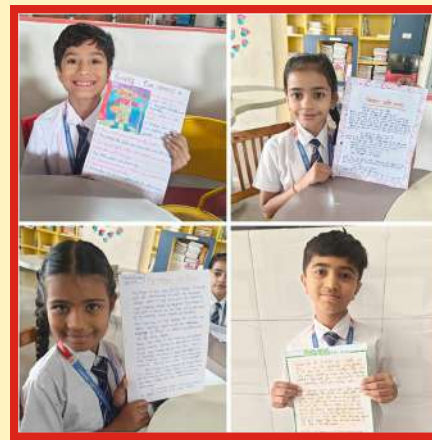
